



Reduced Rate Application: Frequently Asked Questions

APPLICATION PROCESS AND ELIGIBILITY

1. What is the application based on? Am I eligible?

The application is based on your total household income. To be eligible to receive our reduced rate, your total household income will have to be below \$60,000/year. You will receive a percentage discount off of all CCNM Integrative Cancer Centre (CCNM ICC) services and therapies depending on your total household income. In addition, you need to be a patient of the CCNM ICC and have been diagnosed with cancer.

2. How do I apply for the reduced rate?

To apply, you must complete a copy of the CCNM ICC Reduced Rate Application.

All new patients receive a copy of the application if they provide their email address. The application is also available on our website on our Fees page under Subsidy Program:

We require the most recent Notice of Assessment for all household members over the age of 18 to be submitted with your application as proof of income.

3. What if I don't have a copy of my Notice of Assessment?

If you do not have your most recent Notice of Assessment, you can contact Canada Revenue Agency at 1-800-959-8281 to request it.

4. How long does it take to process the application?

It takes approximately 2 weeks to process the application.

If you would like to have the discount applied to your first appointment, you will have to wait 2 weeks for the application to be processed. You will be charged regular appointment rates until your application is approved.

5. Where do I send the completed reduced rate application?

DISCOUNT AND SERVICES

1. How much of a discount will I receive?

The following percentages will be deducted from the cost of your appointment/therapy. If your income is above \$60,000 you would not be eligible for the reduced rate.

Total Household Income	Discount Amount
\$50,000-\$60,000	20%
\$40,000-\$50,000	30%
\$30,000-\$40,000	40%
Under \$30,000	50%

2. What ICC services will the reduced rate be applied to?

The reduced rate will be applied to ALL of the services offered by the CCNM ICC including the following:

- All appointments with a naturopathic doctor (including Mistletoe consultations)
- Acupuncture
- Massage
- Psychotherapy
- Yoga Therapy and Classes
- Injectables (Mistletoe and B12)
- IV Therapies

3. How much will my naturopathic appointments cost if I am approved?

The full-price cost for a new patient appointment is \$200.00 and follow up appointments are \$120.00. The table below lists the cost of the appointments with the discount applied:

Total Household Income and Discount Amount	Cost of New Patient Appointment	Cost of Follow Up Appointment
\$50,000-\$60,000 at 20%	\$160.00	\$96.00
\$40,000-\$50,000 at 30%	\$140.00	\$84.00
\$30,000-\$40,000 at 40%	\$120.00	\$72.00
Under \$30,000 at 50%	\$100.00	\$60.00

4. What if I am already approved for the reduced rate with the Robert Schad Naturopathic Clinic?

Our reduced rate is generously sponsored through a gift-in-kind donation from York Downs Pharmacy and this funding is only provided for people with cancer at this time.
